



City of Union Gap Transportation Tax Effective April 1, 2008

Effective April 1, 2008, sales and use tax within the City of Union Gap will increase two-tenths of one percent (.002). The tax will be used for transportation purposes.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within the city. Persons or businesses within the City of Union Gap will be subject to the new rate of use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.

The new rate of sales tax is:
